



Slush Machine Hire Agreement & Disclaimer

The **agreement of hire** includes the following **conditions of hire**:

Important precautions

- You must not try to clean the slush machine or dismantle it in any way. Any damage or loss will be subject to a payment to repair or replace. Please leave the machine and we will take it away and clean it as part of the hire.
- If the machine stops working or makes any noise, **please turn off and call us straight away**, failure to do this could result in further damage to the machine.
- The machine must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times. Children should not be allowed to use the machine under any circumstances.
- Do not put your hands or anything apart from the supplied slush mix inside the top bowls as it contains moving parts.
- The machine generates heat around the base so make sure it has space for air circulation
- **DO** not try to lift or move the slush machine
- Only flavour bases supplied by Sweets for my Sweet to be used in the slush machine. Any other liquid could freeze up and damage the machine.
- We will not be held responsible for any liquid spilling or coming from the slush machine and causing any damage to your property

Instructions

- When the machine has been running for an hour and started to freeze up, you can turn down the temperature to around 7 or so, if you find the slush too thick then lowering the temperature down will resolve this.
- Place a cup under the required spout and pull the handle to dispense the required slush.
- We will assemble, fill and set-up the machine to run for you, however during your hire you may need to top up with more slush liquid.
- Never let the metal inside the bowl be exposed and the level of liquid be too low, once it gets to this point turn off that side by pressing the freeze button until it stops working.
- It is better to fill up at regular intervals rather than allowing it to almost empty as it will then take up to an hour to refreeze.
- Open the lid carefully, pour in more of the supplied mixture up to the maximum line and then put the lid back on, repeat for the other bowl if necessary. We suggest doing this once the level goes down about a quarter of the way.
- Never fill with anything except the supplied mix as this can freeze up and cause the machine to stop working, if you do use any other liquid and damage the machine you will be charged for the repairs.
- When you have finished with the machine, turn off the machine by pressing the buttons at front to 0 and unplug at the wall, leave the machine to defrost and for us to take it away
- If you are keeping the machine overnight, turn off as above and leave it off till we collect it the next day.
